Pride and Prejudice

This project asks you to tap your creative side! As you can see below, you have several options. Each choice asks you to use Jane Austen, the late 1700's-1800's in England (part of which is considered the beginning of the Victorian Period (1837-1901) was the reign of Queen Victoria)), or *Pride and Prejudice* as your inspiration. This is a project that you can have fun with and learn about your topic!

1. **ABC book:** Create an illustrated ABC book using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. You need to have a page per letter and at least one color illustration per letter. You may use one word for your letter or a phrase. For example: A is for Austen. Jane Austen the author of *Pride and Prejudice*. Your book also needs an illustrated cover with the book title and your name as the author.
2. **Number book:** Create an illustrated number (1-20) book using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. You need to have a page per number and at least one color illustration per number. You may use one word for your number or a phrase. For example: 3: *Pride and Prejudice* has 3 volumes. Your book also needs an illustrated cover with the book title and your name as the author.
3. **Children's book:** Create an illustrated children's book using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. You need to have text on each page and at least one color illustration per page. Your book should be a minimum of 20 pages. Your book also needs an illustrated cover with the book title and your name as the author.
4. **Board game:** Create a board game using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. You need to have a full-color board, a detailed explanation of the object of the game, a set of directions and rules, and board pieces.
5. **Website:** Create a website of 5 pages or more using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. This could be accomplished by making a PowerPoint. You need to have the following: a title, a purpose for the site (educational, entertainment, or both), activities and information on the site related to its purpose, a minimum of 20 pictures/clip art pieces, a minimum of 5 links to related sites/sources, and the ability to move between pages.
6. **Scrapbook:** Create a scrap book about one of the major characters of the novel using information from the novel, Jane Austen, the era, etc. Your scrapbook needs to have the following: a full-color cover, a minimum of 10 scrapbook pages, a minimum of 20 pictures, captions or text to accompany each picture, memorabilia that corresponds to the person, and decoration.

7. **Character Life box:** Create a character life box about one of the major characters of the novel using information from the novel. Your box needs to have the following: 10-12 items that your chosen character might use on a daily basis or have as a keepsake (no photos), a quote or quotes from the novel to justify each item (the quote or quotes can be spoken by the character or by another character in the novel about your selected character), an appropriate container (a shoebox works well, but it could be another container that would relate to the character), and *an explanation of what these items individually say about your character and the type of person that character is.*

8. Imagine that, after the Bingleys move away from Longbourn, they invite all of the characters of the novel to their new estate for a Masquerade ball. Choose THREE of the characters and create masks that visually represent their personalities. Cut your masks out of heavy material and draw or glue materials and/or words that depict personality traits of your characters. Use colors that symbolize your characters. Be able to discuss the reasons you chose certain colors or objects. Do not put your characters' names on the masks and do not share the identities of your characters with your classmates.

9. There have been several movies made which are based on this novel, but if you were directing a movie version of *Pride and Prejudice*, whom would you choose to play the major roles and where would you set the film? Choose an actor to play each of the following roles, and then write a few sentences for each to explain why you would choose that particular actor to play that role. Decide where you would set the film and explain why.

Create a PowerPoint to explain your choices, including pictures.
